This tale was provided by the author for free, for the purposes of an honest review; therefore, the latter is exactly what I'm providing, as per the remit. The tale is written in a rather strange mix of English that's part British, part American, and not having read the previous tales in the series, I couldn't help but wonder why the author had not included even one single mention of any IRL landmark that could have alerted me/readers as to where the tale was actually set. There could be many reasons for this, but it prevented me from 'seeing/visualising' the tale in situ. Dialogue is, throughout, and from pretty much every character, VERY stilted and not-organic (apologies, as 'not-organic' is going to feature a fair bit in this review); I don't think I've often encountered so much non-contracted speech, which made things seem unrealistic and awkward. The conversations that were meant to be taking place in the heat of the moment, with supposed angst, pain, anger, upset, etc. came across as not-really-believable, sorry. There are proofing and editing issues that took me out of the tale several times; I have read the final version, supplied on release day, and the issues that I'd found on the previous read-through remain. I'm unsure if the author's betas/proofers consists of friends/family, but if so, perhaps it's time to review this, as the many errors caused me to remove 1* from the review, and made the tale feel a bit amateurish. The tale felt not-organic, as did the conversation about bi-sexual/bisexuals (both spellings are used interchangeably) vs gay and labelling people.
