

I think it was unfortunate for Emily's relationship with Becka to go south, especially since it's another case of rich girl / poor girl. And while Emily does need to learn how to ride other horses at a moment's notice, I don't think it was necessary for her to be forced to take a different horse to the clinic due to an injury to Bluebird. And to make the stories more believable, I think Emily needs to learn a little humility every now and then and not win practically every show she enters. At her level and the fact that she's riding a pony vs horses, it's not really likely she would do so much better. Yes, ponies can make tighter turns, but they're also lower to the ground and can't clear the jumps as well as a horse can. The big thumbs-up for the book is for when Emily first arrived at the clinic and everyone was in the house looking at the food and comments were being made about healthy eating and food and such. I commend the author for Emily's belief that it's not healthy to obsess over weight and think it's a big deal to be super skinny. Body image at that age is a huge thing and for Emily to be fairly happy with herself is a wonderful thing.

If you've read any of my other reviews you know I really enjoy this series, Show Jumping Dreams. This book is no different and once again I'm looking forward to book #17. If you love horses I think you'll enjoy this series too!
