I received this book for free in return for an honest review. After reading the first book, I could not wait for the next installment, and I did not wait patiently. However, I am happy to say it was definitely worth the wait. The ending just about slayed me, after all the back and forth between the two main characters, to have such a barrier erected was stressful. The only disappointment from my

perspective was that there were no passages from Cain's point of view, I would have enjoyed reading something from his perspective. Same goes for Malphus. There seems to be so much more to his character than is first revealed. The story, as well as the relationships between Rosalind and Caine, as well as Rosalind and Tammi was very well developed. The dialogue, including Rosalind's snarky inner dialogue had me both laughing and sighing for her self-sabotage in several chapters. Ambrose and Cleo are still a mystery, and I am not sure if I am on their teams yet, but I certainly want to continue the story. Despite the non-stop action, inter-connected stories, and side plots, this book was never confusing, it never came off as rushed, or that the author was trying to fill space. All said, this was a great addition to the series, and the author has gained a huge fan, as the Infernal Magic series is also a new favorite of mine. I cannot wait for book 3, and hopefully a new release of Cain and Malphus P.O.V.'s!!
