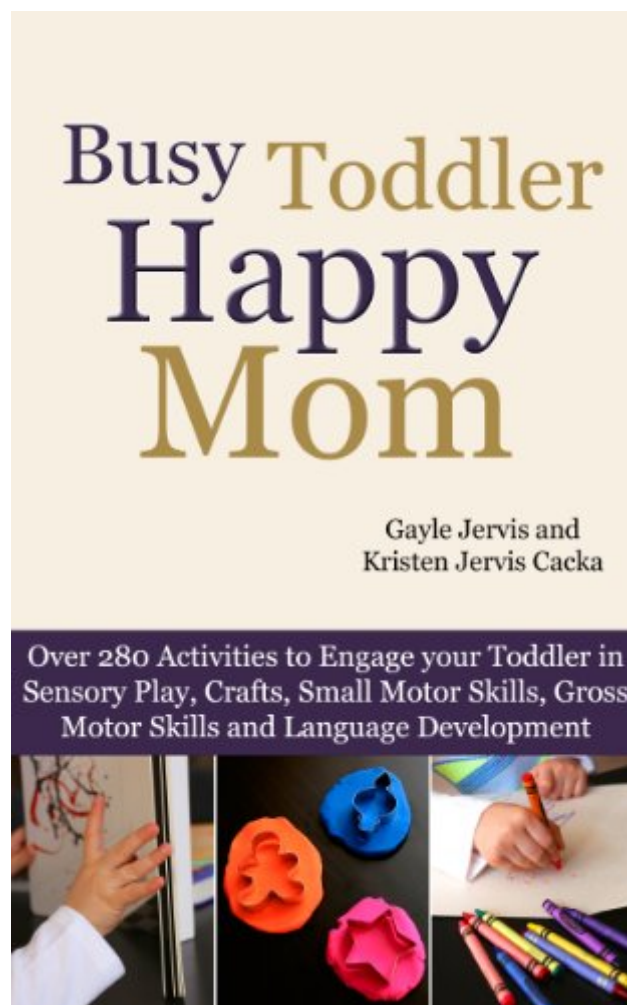

I think the title of this book is misleading. It's more like "learn to teach your kid". I bought this book with the hope of finding activities that would keep my kids busy while I cooked or did laundry or got some other work done. Instead most of these activities have to be supervised and discussions need to be engaged. I do this already and don't need help teaching my kids about the world and vocabulary. That being said, the suggestions in this book seem like great lessons and conversation starters but the book is nothing what I expected.

I was looking for books with had ideas about activities to do with some students at school. I stumbled across this, looked at the price and thought, why not?? I am glad I bought it, it has no pictures but it's CHOCK FULL of ideas. The author has 5 different sections in the book: 1. Small Motor - 41 different activities. 2. Gross Motor - 49 different activities. 3. Arts and Crafts - 52 activities. 4. Sensory - 40 activities. 5. Books - 48 suggestions AND activities to go with the book - in my 8 years of working with preschool and kindergarten children, I've looked through a lot of teacher resources. I am fairly sure this is the first time I have seen someone offer this. 6. Language - 52 activities. Unless my math is off, that is 281 activities that you can do with your child/children. Let me be blunt, you are getting this women's MANY years of experience for .99 cents!!! What can you get for that these days?!! Give this some serious thought the next time you are looking for a book of things to do with your child, you will not be disappointed.
